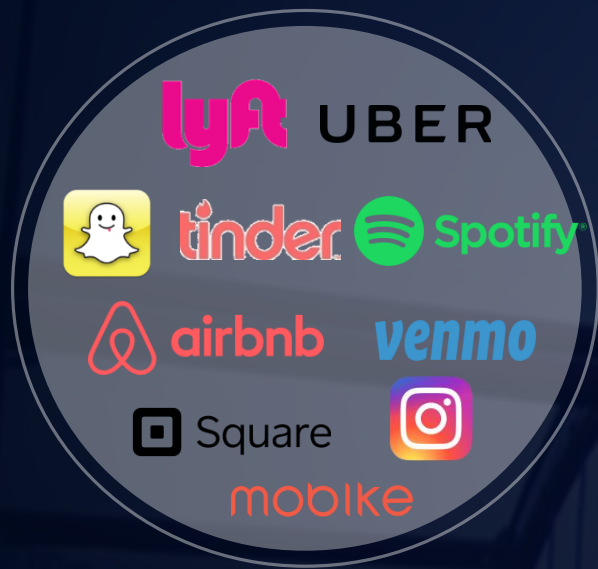

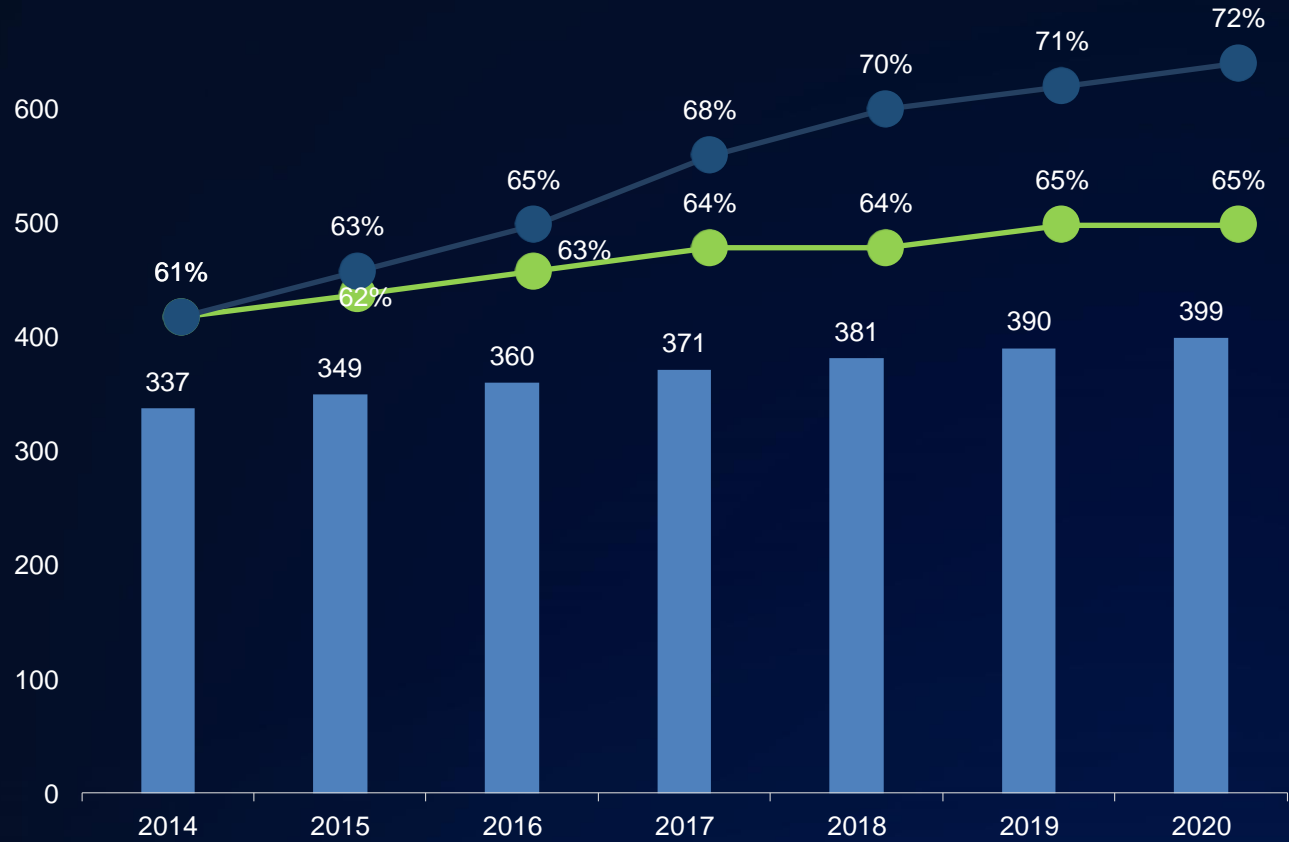

Unique Subscribers in MENA



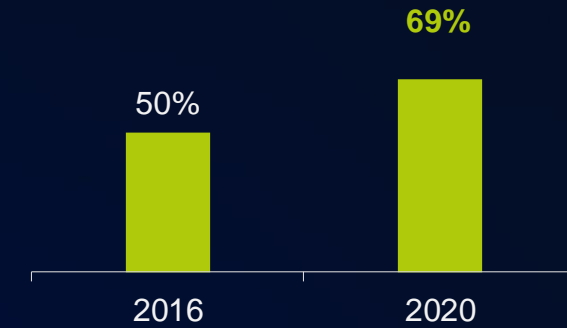
Unique subscribers (million)

Penetration (% population)

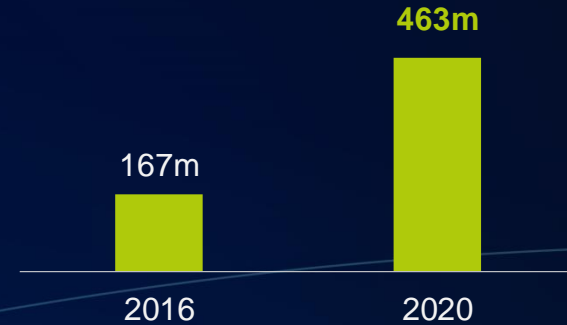

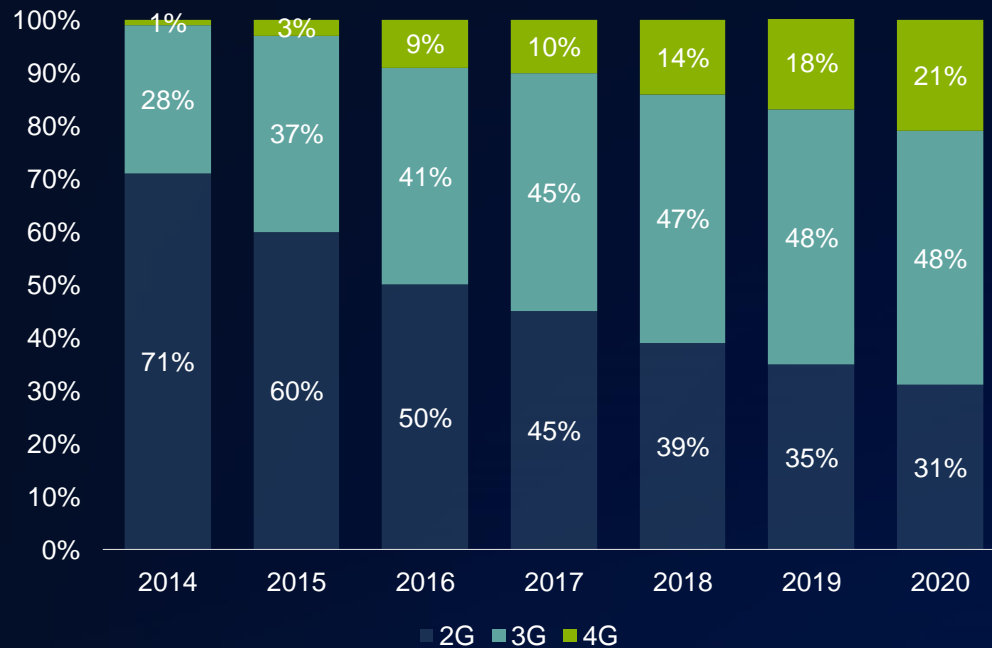

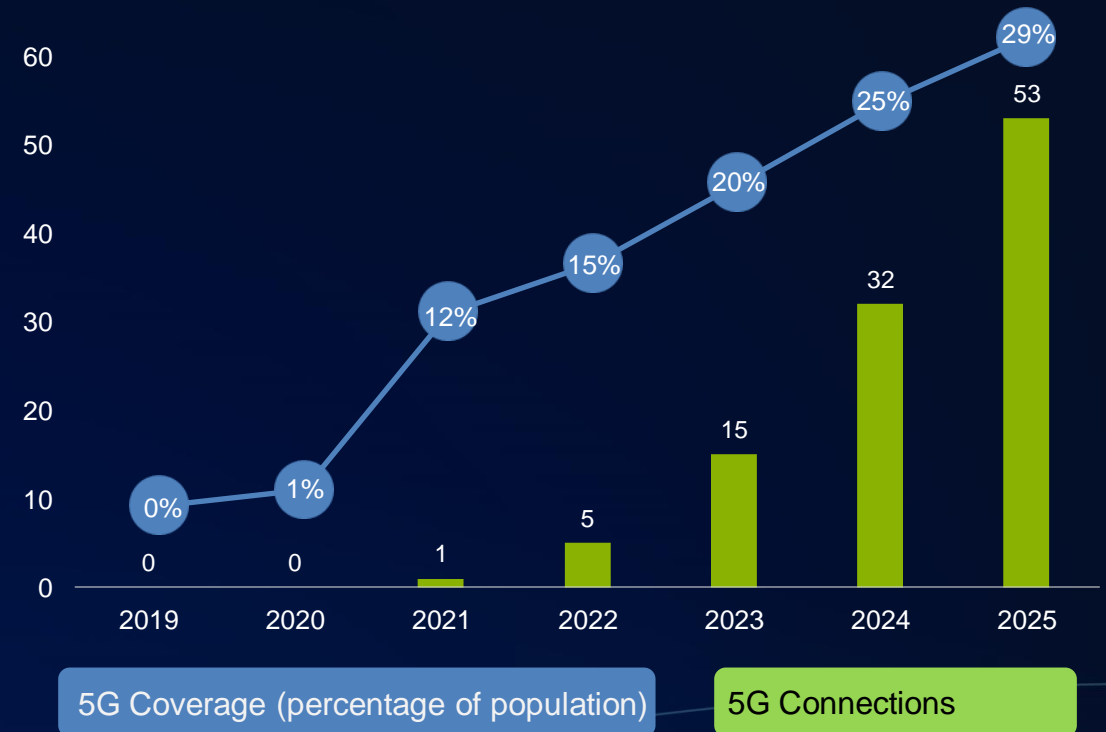
5G Is Predicted to Cover ~30% Pop. Of MENA by 2025

Percentage of connections

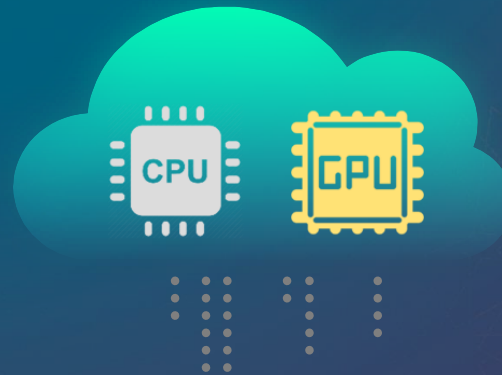


5G take-up in MENA

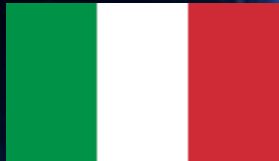

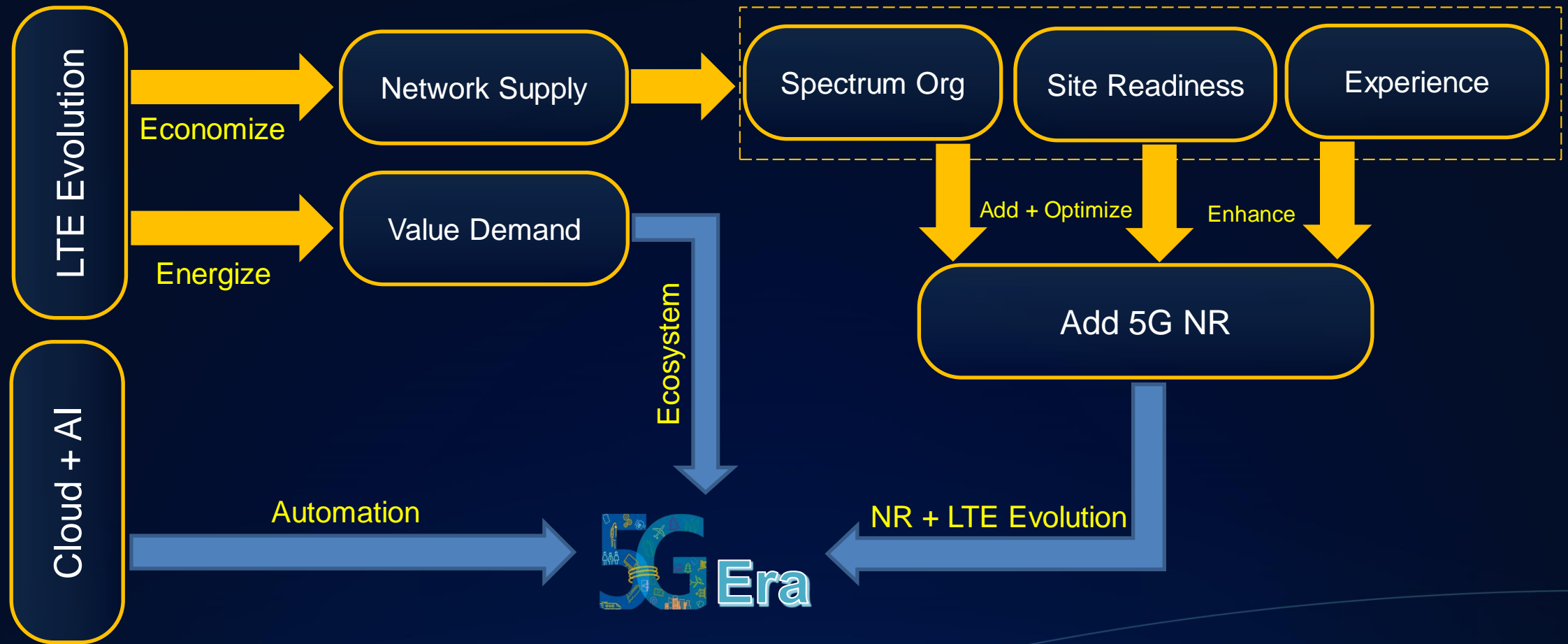

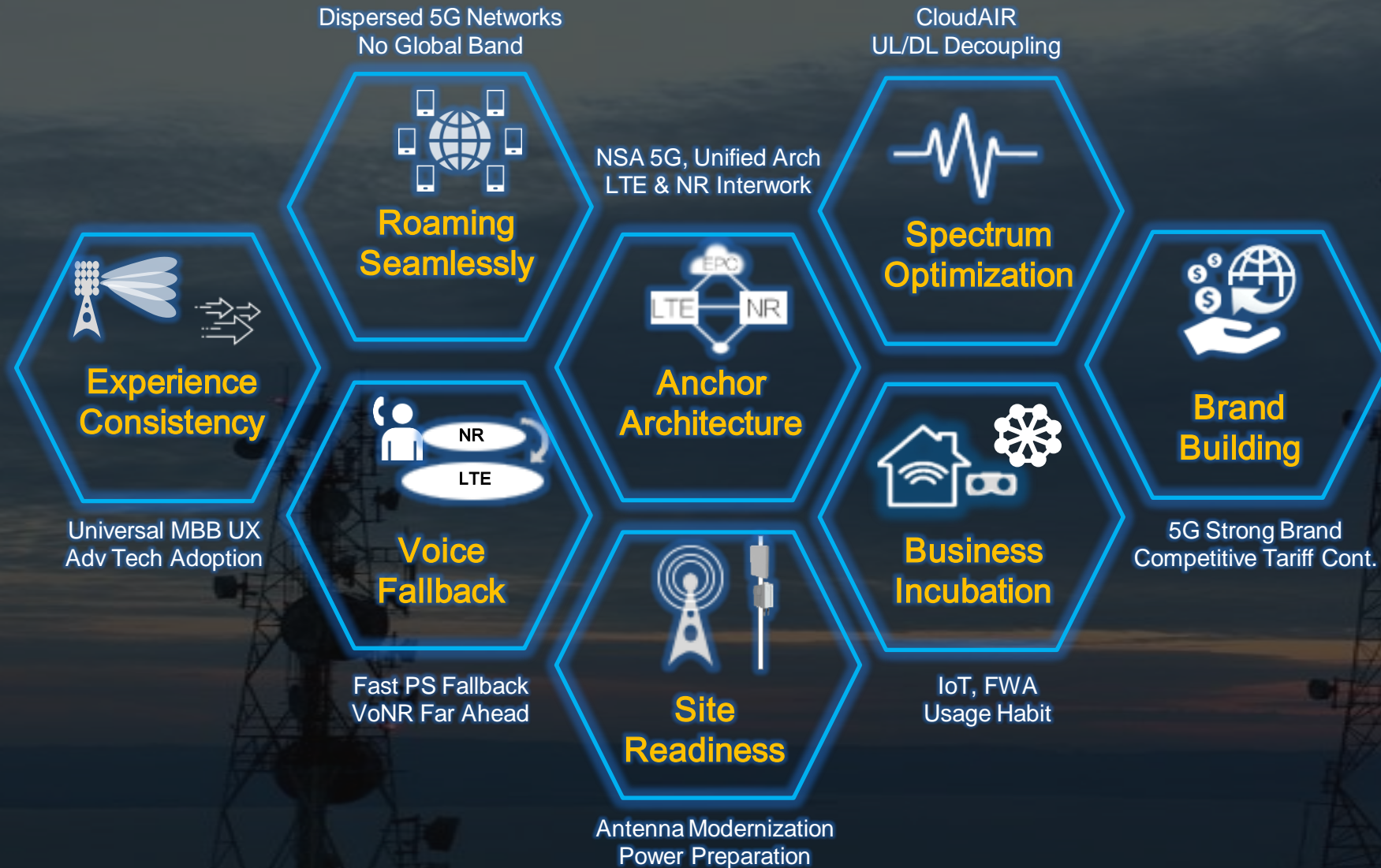
